1. The specifications and drawings for Invitation No. DACW64-02-B-0002, Dredging, Main Channel in Matagorda Bay and Natural Bay Bottom Route in Matagorda County, Texas, advertised 19 October 2001, and for which bids are rescheduled to be opened on 17 January 2002, are hereby modified as follows:

(a) Specifications.

(1) STANDARD FORM 1441, Item 12B CALENDAR DAYS. - Change "10" to "2."

(2) BIDDING SCHEDULE, Pages 00010-1 and 00010-2. - The enclosed Bidding Schedule, Pages 00010-1 and 00010-2 supersedes that issued by Amendment No. 0002 to this Invitation.

(3) Page 02482-5, Paragraph 3.1. - Delete this Paragraph in its entirety and substitute the following therefor:

"3.1 ESTIMATED QUANTITIES.

"3.1.1 Required Dredging Prism. The total estimated quantities of material necessary to be removed from the required dredging prism, exclusive of allowable overdepth, to complete the work specified in the Paragraph: DESCRIPTION OF WORK above, in cubic yards in-place measurement, including anticipated shoaling occurring prior to the dates of the "before-dredging" sections are as follows:

The work is to be done in accordance with this contract and at the contract price or prices, subject to the provisions of NON-REGULATED SPECIAL CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS CLAUSE entitled VARIATIONS IN ESTIMATED QUANTITIES - DREDGING."








- (1) Obviously misplaced decimal points will be corrected;
- (2) Discrepancy between unit price and extended price, the unit price will govern;
- (3) Apparent errors in extension of unit prices will be corrected;
- (4) Apparent errors in addition of lump-sum and extended prices will be corrected.

(b) For the purpose of bid evaluation, the Government will proceed on the assumption that the bidder intends his bid to be evaluated on the basis of the unit prices, the totals arrived at by resolution of arithmetic discrepancies as provided above and the bid will be so reflected on the abstract of bids.

(c) These correction procedures shall not be used to resolve any ambiguity concerning which bid is low.








2. MODIFICATIONS (CESWG). If a modification to a bid based on unit prices is submitted, which provides for a lump sum adjustment to the total estimated cost, the application of the lump sum adjustment of each unit price in the bid schedule must be stated. If it is not stated, the bidder agrees that the lump sum adjustment shall be applied on a pro rata basis to every unit price in the bid schedule.

3. EVALUATION OF OPTIONS (JUL 1990)(FAR 52.217-5).
