The specifications and drawings for Invitation No. DACW64-02-B-0024, Dredging, Sabine Pass Outer Bar and Sabine Bank Channels in Jefferson County, Texas and Cameron Parish, Louisiana, Sabine-Neches Waterway, Texas, advertised 26 April 2002, and for which bids were postponed, are hereby modified as follows:

BID OPENING DATE IS HEREBY RESCHEDULED FOR 2:30 PM LOCAL TIME, ROOM 175, JADWIN BUILDING, 16 JULY 2002.

IN REFERENCE TO A QUESTION FROM A CONTRACTOR, THE FOLLOWING CLARIFICATION IS PROVIDED:

Q. In Section 02482-2, paragraph 3.2.1 states that “trawling shall be conducted for a period of 5 days immediately preceding commencement of dredging operations.” Is this trawling mandatory regardless if Option 1 or Option 2 is exercised? Or is this paragraph in effect only if either option is exercised?

A. Trawling is required for 5 days prior to commencement of dredging regardless of which option is involved.

(a) Specifications.

(1) STANDARD FORM 1442, Item 12(b). - Change “10” to “2.”

(2) BIDDING SCHEDULE, Pages 00010-1 Through 00010-4. - The enclosed new Bidding Schedule, Pages 00010-1 through 00010-4 supersedes that issued with Amendment No. 0001 to this Invitation.

(3) Page 01100-1, Paragraph 1. - In the first sentence, after the word “commence” insert “trawling within 5 days after the date of request of Notice to Proceed and.”

(5) Page 02482-5, Subparagraph 3.1.1. - Delete this Subparagraph and substitute the following:

“3.1.1 Required Dredging Prism. The total estimated quantities of material necessary to be removed from the required dredging prism, exclusive of allowable overdepth, to complete the work specified in the Paragraph: SCOPE OF WORK above, in cubic yards in-place measurement, including anticipated shoaling occurring prior to the dates of the "before-dredging" sections are as follows:

Sabine Bank Channel	337,000 Cubic Yards
Sabine Pass Outer Bar Channel	830,000 Cubic Yards

(5) Page 02482-5, Subparagraph 3.1.2. - Delete this Subparagraph and substitute the following:

“3.1.2 **Overdepth.** The maximum amount of allowable overdepth dredging is estimated in cubic yards in-place measurement, including anticipated shoaling occurring prior to the dates of the "before-dredging" sections are as follows:

(6) Page 02482-6, Paragraph 3.2. - Delete this Paragraph in its entirety and substitute the following therefor:

1. ARITHMETIC DISCREPANCIES (JAN 1997)(EFARS 52.214-5000).

(a) For the purpose of initial evaluation of bids, the following will be utilized in resolving arithmetic discrepancies found on the face of bidding schedule as submitted by the bidder:

- (1) Obviously misplaced decimal points will be corrected;
- (2) Discrepancy between unit price and extended price, the unit price will govern;
- (3) Apparent errors in extension of unit prices will be corrected;
- (4) Apparent errors in addition of lump-sum and extended prices will be corrected.

(b) For the purpose of bid evaluation, the Government will proceed on the assumption that the bidder intends his bid to be evaluated on the basis of the unit prices, the totals arrived at by resolution of arithmetic discrepancies as provided above and the bid will be so reflected on the abstract of bids.

(c) These correction procedures shall not be used to resolve any ambiguity concerning which bid is low.

2. MODIFICATIONS (CESWG). If a modification to a bid based on unit prices is submitted, which provides for a lump sum adjustment to the total estimated cost, the application of the lump sum adjustment of each unit price in the bid schedule must be stated. If it is not stated, the bidder agrees that the lump sum adjustment shall be applied on a pro rata basis to every unit price in the bid schedule.

4 EVALUATION OF OPTIONS (JUL 1990)(FAR 52.217-5). Except when it is determined in accordance with FAR 17.206(b) not to be in the Government's best interests, the government will evaluate offers for award purposes by adding the total price for all options to the total price for the basic requirement. Evaluation of options will not obligate the Government to exercise the options.
