1. The specifications and drawings for Invitation No. DACW64-03-B-0002, Dredging Bolivar Roads to Pier "B," U. S. Army Corps of Engineers Boat Basin, and U. S. Coast Guard Docking Facilities in Galveston County, Texas, advertised 15 October 2002, and for which bids are rescheduled to be opened on 30 December 2002 are hereby modified as follows:

(a) Specifications.

(1) Amendment No. 0006, Page A0006-2, Item (3), FAR 217-7 OPTION FOR INCREASED QUANTITY - SEPARATELY PRICED LINE ITEM (MAR 1999). - Delete this Item and substitute the following therefor:

"FAR 217-7 OPTION FOR INCREASED QUANTITY - SEPARATELY PRICED LINE ITEM (MAR 1999). The Government may require the delivery of the numbered line items, identified in the Schedule as an option item, in the quantity and at the price stated in the Schedule. The Contracting Officer may exercise the Option by written notice to the Contractor by 1 September 2003. Delivery of added items shall continue at the same rate that like items are called for under the contract, unless the parties otherwise agree."

(2) BIDDING SCHEDULE, Pages 00010-1 Through 00010-5 (Issued by Amendment No. 0006, Item (4)). - The enclosed Bidding Schedule, Pages 00010-1 through 00010-4 supersedes that issued with Amendment No. 0006 to this Invitation.

(3) Page 01100-1, Paragraph 1, COMMENCEMENT, PROSECUTION, AND COMPLETION OF WORK (CESWG) (Issued by Amendment No. 0006, Item (6)). - Delete this Item and substitute the following therefor:

"1. COMMENCEMENT, PROSECUTION, AND COMPLETION OF WORK (CESWG). The Contractor will be required to commence work under this contract within 5 calendar days after the date of receipt of Notice to Proceed, to prosecute said work diligently and to complete the entire work ready for use not later than 90 calendar days after date of receipt of Notice to Proceed for Schedule No. 1, and an additional 185 calendar days for the Option will be added to the contract if executed."

(4) Page 02319-1, Subparagraph 1.4.1. - Delete this Subparagraph and substitute the following:

"1.4.1 Stripping and the cost therewith will be included in the contract lump sum price for "Levees, Drop-outlets, and Ditches for San Jacinto Placement Area," "Pelican Island Levee Repair - Stations 311+64 to 318+20" or under Bid Item Option "Levees, Drop-outlets, and Ditches for Pelican Island Placement Area."

(5) Page 02329-2, Subparagraph 1.6.2 (Issued by Amendment No. 0003, Item (9)). - Delete this Subparagraph and substitute the following:

"1.6.2 Levee Construction. Payment for excavation and placement for the fill for levee construction will be included in the contract lump sum price for "Levees, Drop-outlets, and Ditches for San Jacinto Placement Area," or under Bid Item Option "Levees, Drop-outlets, and Ditches for Pelican Island Placement Area."

(6) Page 02329-2, Subparagraph 1.6.3. - Delete this Subparagraph and substitute the following:

"1.6.3 Stripping and Clearing for existing levees, foundation and borrow areas, and placement of stripped material and the costs in connection therewith will be included in the lump sum price for "Levees, Drop-outlets, and Ditches for San Jacinto Placement Area," "Pelican Island Levee Repair - Stations 311+64 to 318+20" or under Bid Item Option "Levees, Drop-outlets, and Ditches for Pelican Island Placement Area."

(7) SECTION 02329, Page 5, Subparagraph 3.1.1 (Issued with Amendment No. 0006, Item No. (10)). - In the third line, delete the sentence beginning with: "The assembled mattresses shall have. . . ."

1. ARITHMETIC DISCREPANCIES (EFARS 52.214-5000).

(a) For the purpose of initial evaluation of bids, the following will be utilized in resolving arithmetic discrepancies found on the face of bidding schedule as submitted by the bidder:

- (1) Obviously misplaced decimal points will be corrected;
- (2) Discrepancy between unit price and extended price, the unit price will govern;
- (3) Apparent errors in extension of unit prices will be corrected;
- (4) Apparent errors in addition of lump-sum and extended prices will be corrected.

(b) For the purpose of bid evaluation, the Government will proceed on the assumption that the bidder intends his bid to be evaluated on the basis of the unit prices, the totals arrived at by resolution of arithmetic discrepancies as provided above and the bid will be so reflected on the abstract of bids.

(c) These correction procedures shall not be used to resolve any ambiguity concerning which bid is low.

2. MODIFICATIONS (CESWG). If a modification to a bid based on unit prices is submitted, which provides for a lump sum adjustment to the total estimated cost, the application of the lump sum adjustment of each unit price in the bid schedule must be stated. If it is not stated, the bidder agrees that the lump sum adjustment shall be applied on a pro rata basis to every unit price in the bid schedule.

3. EVALUATION OF OPTIONS (JUL 1990) (FAR 52.217-5). Except when it is determined in accordance with FAR 17.206(b) not to be in the Government's best interests, the Government will evaluate offers for award purposes by adding the total price for all options to the total price for the basic requirement. Evaluation of Options will not obligate the Government to exercise the options.

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
