**1. ARITHMETIC DISCREPANCIES (EFARS 52.214-5000).**

(a) For the purpose of initial evaluation of bids, the following will be utilized in resolving arithmetic discrepancies found on the face of bidding schedule as submitted by the bidder:

- (1) Obviously misplaced decimal points will be corrected;
- (2) Discrepancy between unit price and extended price, the unit price will govern;
- (3) Apparent errors in extension of unit prices will be corrected;
- (4) Apparent errors in addition of lump-sum and extended prices will be corrected.

(b) For the purpose of bid evaluation, the Government will proceed on the assumption that the bidder intends his bid to be evaluated on the basis of the unit prices, the totals arrived at by resolution of arithmetic discrepancies as provided above and the bid will be so reflected on the abstract of bids.

(c) These correction procedures shall not be used to resolve any ambiguity concerning which bid is low.

**2. MODIFICATIONS (CESWG).** If a modification to a bid based on unit prices is submitted, which provides for a lump sum adjustment to the total estimated cost, the application of the lump sum adjustment of each unit price in the bid schedule must be stated. If it is not stated, the bidder agrees that the lump sum adjustment shall be applied on a pro rata basis to every unit price in the bid schedule.

**PART 1 - GENERAL**

**1.1 SCOPE OF WORK.** The work covered in this Section consists of furnishing plant, labor, and equipment for performing operations specified herein for the installation of signs.

**1.2 MEASUREMENT.**

1.2.1 Signs shall be measured by each unit for payment.

**1.3 PAYMENT.**

1.3.1 Signs. Payment for the signs will be made at the contract unit price each for "Signs," which price shall include labor, material, and equipment to accomplish the work specified herein.

**PART 2 - PRODUCTS**

**2.1 SIGNS.**

2.1.1 General. The Contractor shall furnish, install, and maintain warnings signs for the duration of this contract warning signs that meet the requirements specified in the Table below:

2.1.1.1 Mounting Post shall consist of 2-inch Poly(Vinyl Chloride) pipe of sufficient length to ensure that the embedment depth is equal to the length above the Bay bottom.

### **PART 3 - EXECUTION**

**3.1 INSTALLATION.** The signs shall be mounted so that the bottom of the sign is at least 5 feet above normal water level.

3.1.1 Placement Area No. 128. The Contractor shall install signs along the exterior of the new and existing geotextile tubes at a distance of 5 feet from the exterior of the geotextile anchor tube. The signs shall be spaced at a distance of 300-feet along the exterior of the geotextile anchor tube erected on double posts with one (1) face to the west and one to the east.

3.1.2 Beneficial Use Site "J". The Contractor shall install signs along the exterior of the new riprap breakwater at a distance of 5 feet from the exterior toe of the new riprap breakwater. The signs shall be spaced at a distance of 300 feet along the exterior of the new riprap breakwater erected on double posts with one (1) face to the west and one to the east.
