The specifications and drawings for Invitation No. DACW64-03-B-0010, Dredging, Mile 293 to High Island in Jefferson, Chambers, and Galveston Counties, Texas, Gulf Intracoastal Waterway, Texas, advertised 14 March 2003, and for which bids are scheduled to be opened on 15 April 2003, are hereby modified as follows:

(a) Specifications.

(1) BIDDING SCHEDULE, Pages 00010-1 Through 00010-4 (Issued by Amendment No. 0001). - The enclosed Bidding Schedule, Pages 00010-1 through 00010-4 supersedes that issued with Amendment No. 0001 to this Invitation.

(2) Page 00100-12. - At the end of this Section, add the following new Provision:

"52.1-4007 PREAWARD INFORMATION DREDGING (CESWG-CT).

The apparent low bidder shall submit within five (5) working days after Bid Opening, the following information:

(a) A statement as to whether he is now or ever has been engaged in performing dredging of shallow draft channels.

(b) A list of key personnel available for the current project and their qualifications.

(c) A copy of the bidder's latest financial statement, including the names of banks or other financial institutions with which the bidder conducts business. If the financial statement is more than 60 days old, a certificate should be attached stating that the financial condition is substantially the same, or if not the same, the changes that have taken place. Such statement will be treated as confidential.

(d) A list of present commitments, including the dollar value thereof, name of office under which the work is being performed, the scheduled completion date of each, days ahead or behind schedule and the name of the Dredge to be used on the job.

(e) Name and location of the firm's dredging plant to perform the work under this contract, the date this plant will commence work, and the plants capability to perform the work as required by the specifications.

(f) If bidder is a Large Business, a Sub-Contracting Plan, if required, must be submitted within five (5) days after Bid Opening."

(3) Page 01100-6, Paragraph 17 (Issued by Amendment No. 0001, Item (2)). - In Subparagraphs (b) and (c), delete "Bid Item 0004" and substitute "Dredging on the Bid Schedule."

(4) SECTION 02222, REMOVAL OF EXISTING DROP-OUTLET STRUCTURES (Issued with Amendment No. 0001). - Delete this Section and substitute the enclosed new SECTION 02222 entitled REMOVAL OF EXISTING DROP-OUTLET STRUCTURES.

(5) Page 02482-3, Subparagraph 1.7.2 (Issued by Amendment No. 0001, Item (7). - In the third line, delete "approved discharge corridors" and substitute "Beneficial Use Sites."

(6) Page 02482-6, Paragraph 3.2. - In the Table, first column, change "Station" to "Section."

(7) Page 02482-8, Subparagraph 3.4.2.1. - In the fifth line, after the word "Area," delete "and within the discharge corridor."

(8) Page 02482-8, Subparagraph 3.4.2.2. - In the fifth line, after the word "Area," delete "and within the discharge corridor."

(9) Page 02482-10, Subparagraph 3.4.2.13. - At the end of this Subparagraph, add the following Table:

1. ARITHMETIC DISCREPANCIES (JAN 1997) (EFARS 52.214-5000).

(a) For the purpose of initial evaluation of bids, the following will be utilized in resolving arithmetic discrepancies found on the face of bidding schedule as submitted by the bidder:

- (1) Obviously misplaced decimal points will be corrected;
- (2) Discrepancy between unit price and extended price, the unit price will govern;
- (3) Apparent errors in extension of unit prices will be corrected;
- (4) Apparent errors in addition of lump-sum and extended prices will be corrected.

(b) For the purpose of bid evaluation, the Government will proceed on the assumption that the bidder intends his bid to be evaluated on the basis of the unit prices, the totals arrived at by resolution of arithmetic discrepancies as provided above and the bid will be so reflected on the abstract of bids.

(c) These correction procedures shall not be used to resolve any ambiguity concerning which bid is low.

2. MODIFICATIONS (CESWG). If a modification to a bid based on unit prices is submitted, which provides for a lump sum adjustment to the total estimated cost, the application of the lump sum adjustment of each unit price in the bid schedule must be stated. If it is not stated, the bidder agrees that the lump sum adjustment shall be applied on a pro rata basis to every unit price in the bid schedule.

3. EVALUATION OF OPTIONS (JUL 1999) (FAR 52.217-5). Except when it is determined in accordance with FAR 17.206(b) not to be in the Government's best interests, the Government will evaluate offers for award purposes by adding the total price for all options to the total price for the basic requirement. Evaluation of Options will not obligate the Government to exercise the options.

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SECTION 02222 - REMOVAL OF EXISTING DROP-OUTLET STRUCTURES

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.1 SCOPE OF WORK. The work covered under this Section consists of furnishing plant, labor, materials, and equipment and performing the operations in connection with removal of existing Drop-Outlet Structures. Locations are as shown.

1.2 MEASUREMENT.

1.2.1 Removal of Existing Drop-outlet Structure will not be measured for payment.

1.3 PAYMENT

1.3.1 Removal of Existing Drop-outlet Structures Payment for the work covered under this Section and the costs in connection therewith, will be included in the contract lump sum price for "Levees, Drop-outlets, and Ditches-P.A. Nos. 8, 11, 13, 17,20, 23, 24, and 26" under Schedule No. 1, "Levees, Drop-outlets, and Ditches-P.A. Nos. 4 and 6" under Option No. 1 or "Levees, Drop-outlets, and Ditches-P.A. Nos. 4 and 6" under Option No. 2." The contract price shall constitute full compensation for labor and equipment used to complete the work specified herein.

PART 3 - EXECUTION

3.1 REMOVAL OF EXISTING DROP-OUTLET STRUCTURES. Wood and structural steel that comprise the superstructure shall be removed above its concrete slab base. The concrete slab and piling beneath it may be allowed to remain intact.

3.2 DISPOSAL OF MATERIALS. Unsuitable soft materials shall be disposed inside the Placement Area. Pipes, wood, metal, and other related debris shall become the property of the Contractor and shall be disposed off-site at locations provided by the Contractor in compliance with the Federal, State, and local laws and ordinances.

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
