1. The specifications and drawings for Invitation No. DACW64-03-B-0024, Repair to South Jetty in Nueces County, Texas, Corpus Christi Ship Channel, Texas, advertised 21 May 2003, and for which bids are to be opened on 24 June 2003, are hereby modified as follows:

(a) Specifications.

(1) BIDDING SCHEDULE, Pages 00010-1 Through 00010-4. - The enclosed Bidding Schedule, Pages 00010-1 through 00010-4 supersedes that issued with this Invitation.

(2) Page 00700-105 of 105, CLAUSE FAR 52.217-7 OPTION FOR INCREASED QUANTITY-SEPARATELY PRICED LINE ITEM (MAR 1989). - The following new CLAUSE FAR 52.217-7 entitled OPTION FOR INCREASED QUANTITY-SEPARATELY PRICED LINE ITEM (MAR 1989) shall be added to this Section:

"FAR 52.217-7 OPTION FOR INCREASED QUANTITY-SEPARATELY PRICED LINE ITEM (MAR 1989). The Government may require the delivery of the numbered line item, identified in the Schedule as an option item, in the quantity and at the price stated in the Schedule. The Contracting Officer may exercise the option by written notice to the Contractor within 45 days after the date of acknowledgement of the Notice to Proceed. Delivery of added items shall continue at the same rate that like items are called for under the contract, unless the parties otherwise agree.

(End of Clause)"

(3) Page 02314-1, Paragraph 1.3. - Delete the last sentence of this Paragraph and substitute the following: "Temporary roads shall be removed prior to completion of the Jetty and the materials excavated shall be placed or disposed as specified herein."

(4) Page 02382-7, Subparagraph 2.1.5.1. - In the second line, change "blanket stone" to "core stone."

(5) Page 02382-9, Subparagraph 3.1.5. - Delete the first sentence of this Subparagraph and substitute the following: "Upon satisfactory excavation, dewatering, and placement in the dry of gabions, RCP, core stone, and blanket stone to the lines and grades indicated, the area shall be backfilled with stockpiled earth materials previously excavated from the site."

(6) Page 02531-2, Paragraph 1.4. - After this Paragraph, renumber Subparagraphs "1.5.1," "1.5.1.1," "1.5.2," "1.5.2.1," and "1.5.2.2" to read "1.4.1," "1.4.1.1," "1.4.2," "1.4.2.1," and "1.4.2.2." Also, renumber Paragraphs "1.6," "1.7," and "1.8" to read "1.5," "1.6," and "1.7."

DETAIL, change "SEE NOTE 1" to read "SEE NOTE 2."

1. ARITHMETIC DISCREPANCIES (JAN 1997) (EFARS 52.214-5000).

(a) For the purpose of initial evaluation of bids, the following will be utilized in resolving arithmetic discrepancies found on the face of bidding schedule as submitted by the bidder:

- (1) Obviously misplaced decimal points will be corrected;
- (2) Discrepancy between unit price and extended price, the unit price will govern;
- (3) Apparent errors in extension of unit prices will be corrected;
- (4) Apparent errors in addition of lump-sum and extended prices will be corrected.

(b) For the purpose of bid evaluation, the Government will proceed on the assumption that the bidder intends his bid to be evaluated on the basis of the unit prices, the totals arrived at by resolution of arithmetic discrepancies as provided above and the bid will be so reflected on the abstract of bids.

(c) These correction procedures shall not be used to resolve any ambiguity concerning which bid is low.

2. MODIFICATIONS (CESWG). If a modification to a bid based on unit prices is submitted, which provides for a lump sum adjustment to the total estimated cost, the application of the lump sum adjustment of each unit price in the bid schedule must be stated. If it is not stated, the bidder agrees that the lump sum adjustment shall be applied on a pro rata basis to every unit price in the bid schedule.

(This Paragraph is not used in Dredging Contracts-It is only for Construction)

3. SMALL BUSINESS AND SMALL DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS SUBCONTRACTING PLAN ((FAR 52.219-9) See CONTRACT CLAUSES.) In reference to the above, the bidder/offeror shall take into consideration only those subcontracts which he/she will award when preparing the subcontracting plan required in FAR.
