He has 30 years of experience in economics, risk analysis and planning with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and has worked on navigation, flood and coastal risk, ecosystem restoration, hydropower, water supply, and recreation studies while with district offices in Galveston, Alaska, and Little Rock.

Mr. Harper started his USACE career in 1989 with the Los Angeles District. Since then, he has worked as a senior planner and economist with the USACE Institute for Water Resources, where he primarily focused on the application of risk and decision analysis methods in water resources planning activities across all business lines. He also worked with Headquarters USACE on the development and implementation of SMART Planning, served as a member of the Levee Safety Policy and Procedures team, and on the senior oversight groups for the dam and levee safety programs.
