Ms. Gloria Vaughn works in the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Region 6 Office of Communities, Tribes, and Environmental Assessment, where she is the Associate Director for Environmental Justice. As Associate Director, Gloria works to ensure that all persons, regardless of race, ethnicity, culture, or income, are protected from unacceptable levels of environmental pollution and hazards and are given the opportunity to meaningfully participate in environmental decisions and processes that may affect their health and or community.

Gloria began her career with EPA in its Region 2 office in New York City before moving to Dallas and has also worked at EPA Headquarters' Offices in Washington, D.C. She has an extensive environmental background having worked in EPA's Air, Water, and Solid Waste programs. Prior to joining EPA, Gloria worked as an asthma/allergy Research Scientist with the Lederle Division of the American Cyanamid Corporation (now Pfizer).
