## Purpose

- 86<sup>th</sup> legislature senate bill 8 directs TWDB to develop a state flood plan, which must:
  - provide for orderly preparation for and response to flood conditions to protect against the loss of life and property;
  - be a guide to state and local flood control policy; and
  - contribute to water development where possible.

### **About Regional Flood Planning**

- First-of-its-kind statewide flood plan
- Watershed-based planning regions
- Bottom-up approach to flood planning
- Transparent process with public input
  - Over 140 public meetings held since October 2020
- Volunteer members representing interest categories
  - Over 600 nominations received for initial 180 voting positions








## Deliverables: Regional Flood Plan Components

- Identify existing infrastructure
- Identify proposed or ongoing flood mitigation projects
- Identify specific flood risk
  - Existing Condition Flood Risk Analyses
  - Future Condition Flood Risk Analyses







### Deliverables: Regional Flood Plan Components (continued)

- Set protection goals and recommend flood management standards
- Identify and Recommend Flood Management Evaluations (FMEs)
- Identify and Recommend Flood Mitigation Projects (FMPs)
  - ✓ Structural and non-structural
  - ✓ Permittable, constructible and implementable
- Identify and Recommend Flood Management Strategies (FMSs)
- Focus both on
  - ✓ Reducing existing flood risks to life and property and
  - ✓ Floodplain management in general to avoid increasing flood risk in the future by keeping future populations out of the way of flood flows













## Draft Floodplain Quilt
