Brazos River Floodgates, Texas**

SITUATION: NAVIGATION RESTRICTIONS

The M/V Snell and crew will be performing work at the Brazos River Floodgates driving buoy anchors in the east and west mooring basins adjacent to the gates. Depending upon the completion of the buoys, they may have time to install a pile cluster in the Brazos River and perform some guidewall repair work. This work may require closure of the Brazos River Floodgates Locks during the designated period of work.

TIME: Work will take place from 06 November 2016 thru 19 November 2016, 6:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. Sunday through Saturday, 7 days a week, including Federal Holidays.

COOPERATION SOLICITED:

Mariners should contact the Lock Master at (979) 233-1251 to confirm the closure time so as to minimize their delay.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with caution after passing arrangements have been made.
