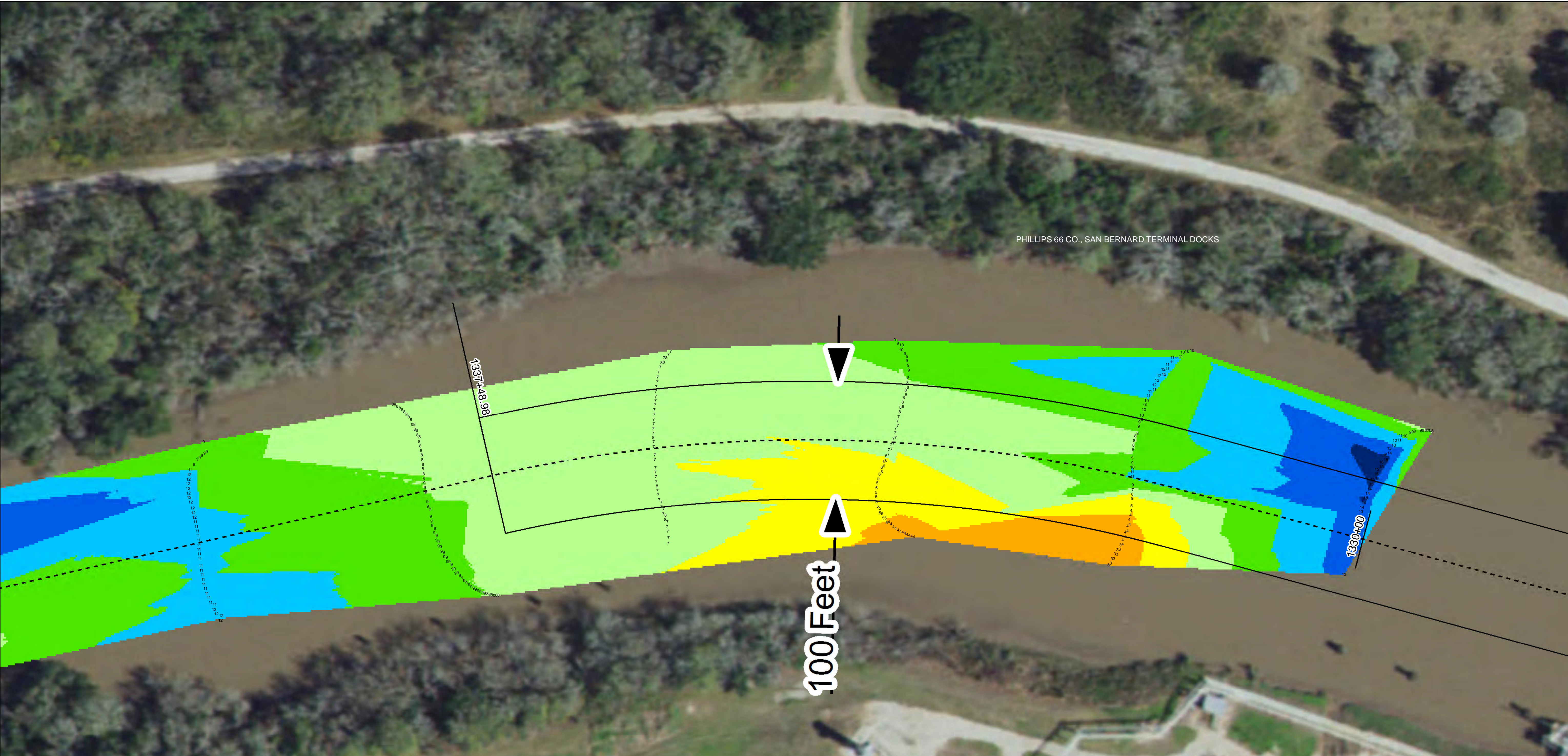
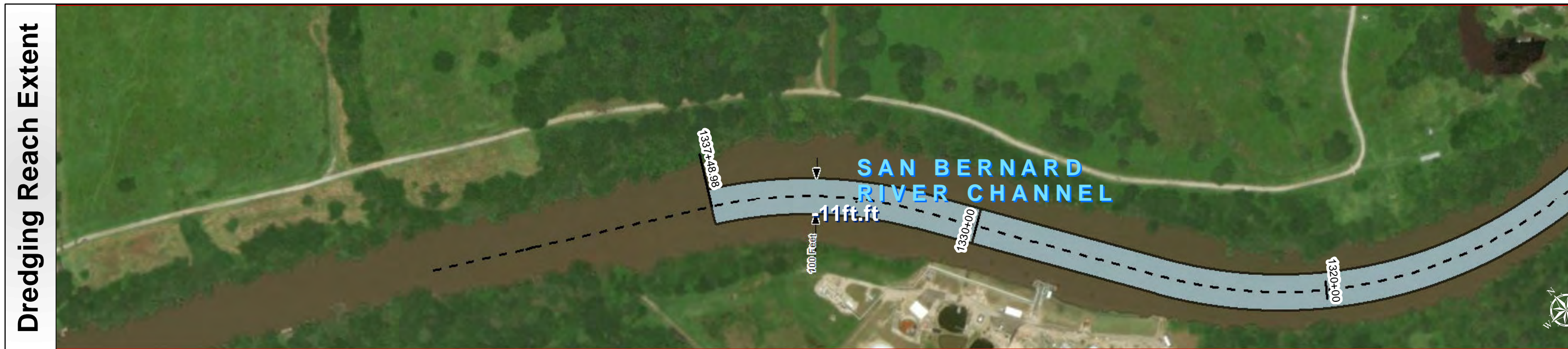
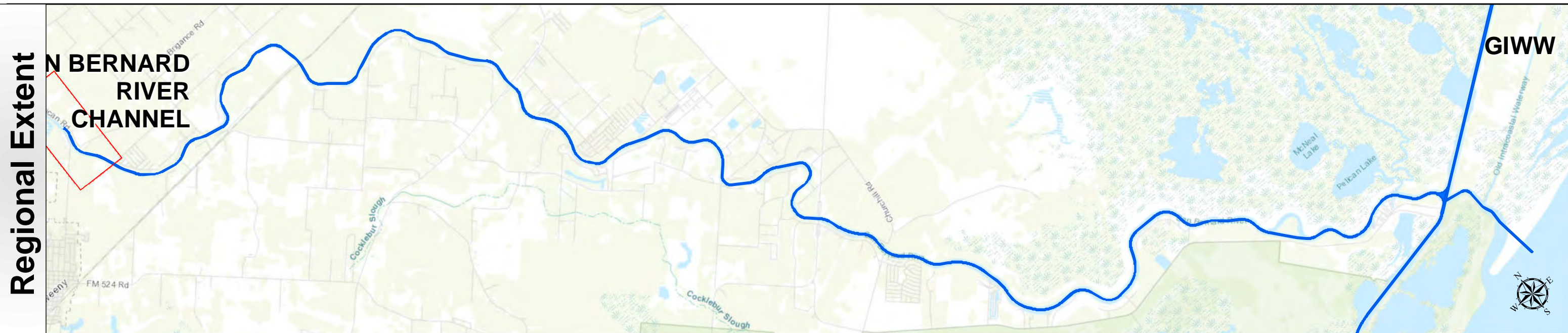


San Bernard River Channel: Mile 25.2 to Mile 26

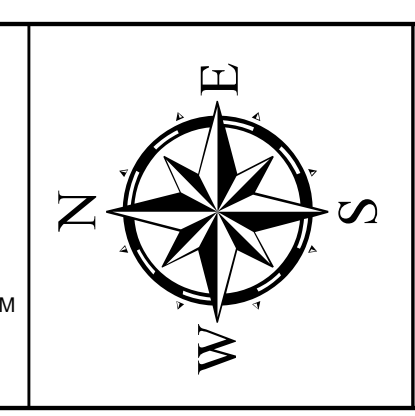

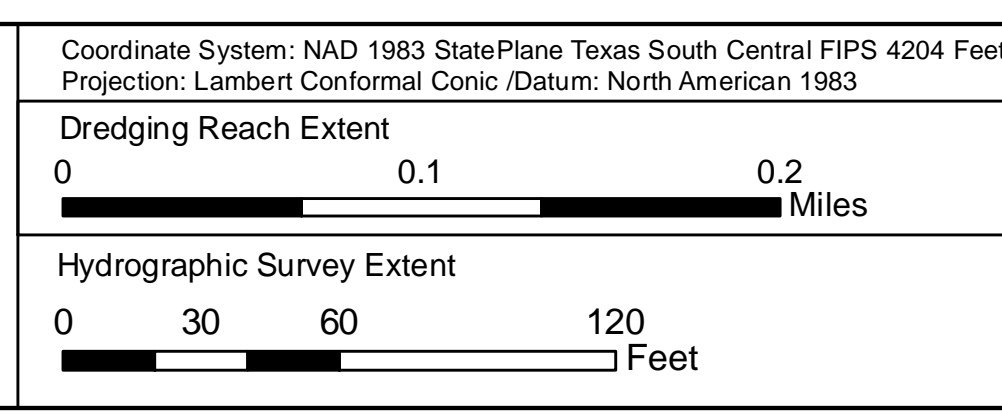
