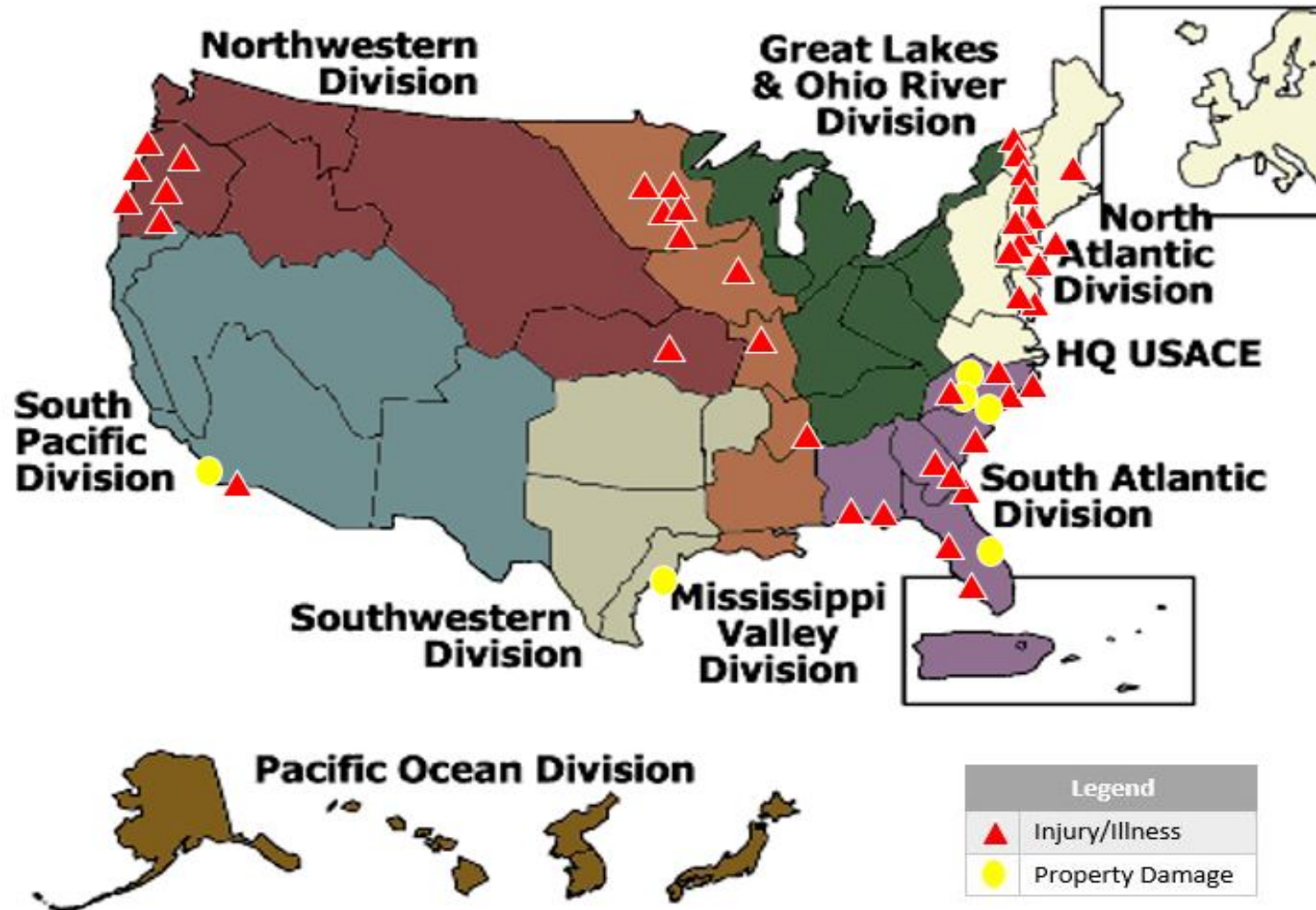

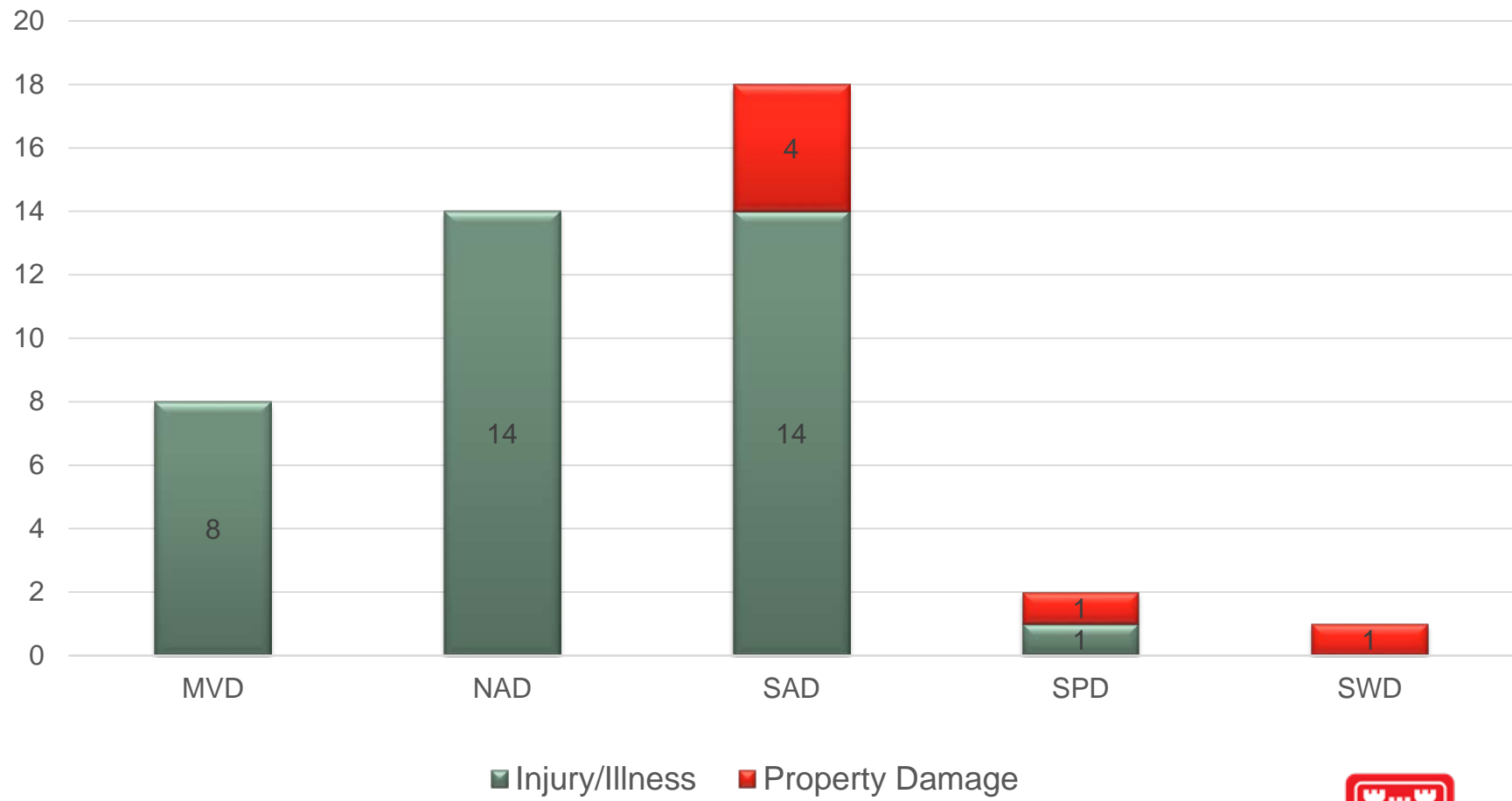

- Total dredging mishaps in FY16: 5

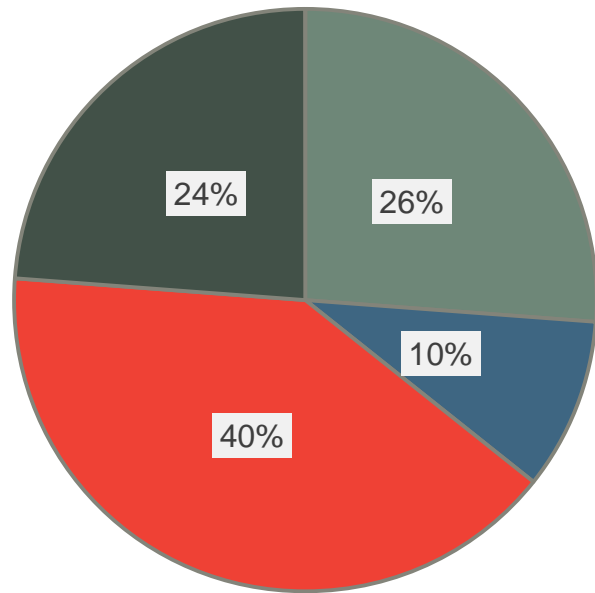

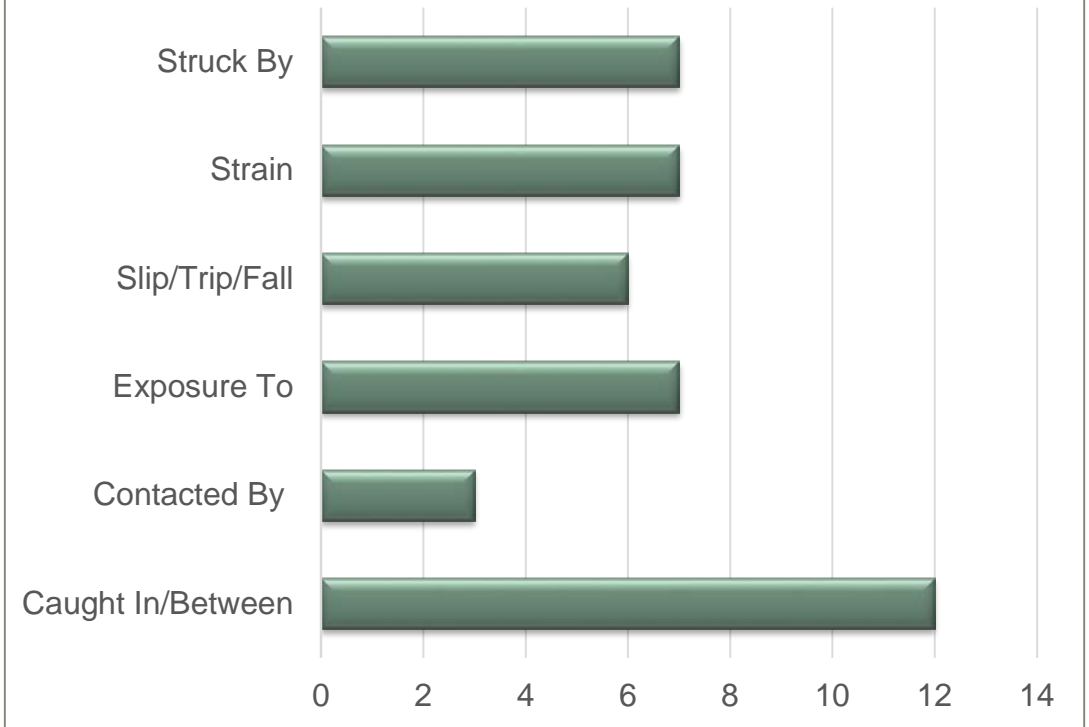
DREDGING INJURIES ACROSS USACE

COMMON ISSUES WITH ACCIDENT PREVENTION PLANS

- SSHO Credentials
 - Resume missing dates of employment
 - No documented continuing education hours
 - Instructor signed OSHA 30-hour card
- Crane Operator Credentials
 - Doctor signed medical physicals
 - Drug screen records

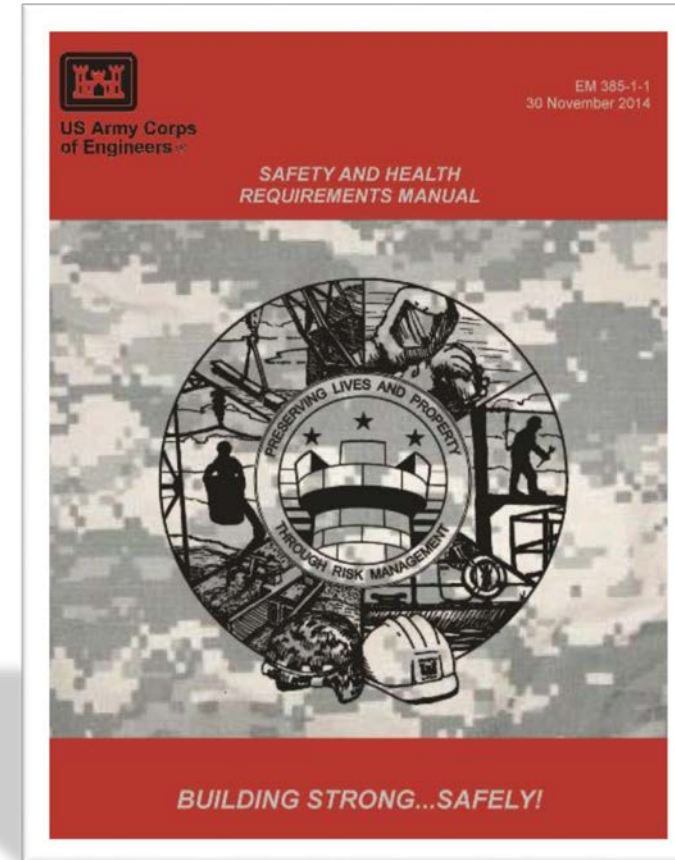
