

New Policy and Guidance

- Communication of Milestone Dates per Section 1002 of WRDA
 - Allows for greater transparency in the notification and reporting of feasibility milestones
 - Five key milestones Reported to Sponsor within 90 days of signed FCSA
 - Release of Draft Report
 - District Submittal of Draft Report
 - MSC Transmittal of Final Report
 - Civil Works Review Board (CWRB)
 - Signed Chief's Report








New Organization and Standards


- More measurable and definable standards are being developed to clearly identify team expectations.

Innovative Scheduling Approach

- New Report to Track Critical Activities before they become "critical"
 - Leveraging Corporate tools such as the Enterprise Data Warehouse (EDW)
 - Tracking Critical Activities monthly during resource meetings
