Duck blind permit winners selected at Wallisville

Seasonal duck blind permit winners were selected today at the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Galveston District's Wallisville Lake Project Office for the 2009-10 hunting season.

A random drawing of 150 names was completed from applications submitted in June. Winners will be notified by mail with instructions for the hunters selection meeting scheduled for Aug. 8 at the Wallisville Lake Visitor's Center. A list of winners will also be posted at the visitor's center.



"There were not quite as many applicants this year as in previous years," said park ranger Russell Malahy. "We're hoping for better weather this season as well, as Hurricane Ike really hurt us last year."
