The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Galveston District is issuing this notice to announce the availability for public review and comment of a Draft Environmental Assessment (DEA) for the Aquatic Plant Control Program (APCP) of Texas, authorized by Section 302 of Public Law 89-298. The purpose of this DEA is to determine the environmental consequences of incorporating all of the river basins of Texas into the USACE Aquatic Plant Control Program for the control of 11 invasive aquatic plant species.
