

Addicks and Barker Reservoirs CWMS Forecast: 06/04/2019 @0800

Tropical moisture combined with a frontal system approaching from the west is forecast to bring a total of approximately 4.0 inches of rainfall in the next 7 days, a majority of this rainfall occurring during the period from 6pm tonight (4 June 2019) through 6am Thursday (6 June 2019).

Addicks and Barker are currently empty with gates open. This forecast assumes the gates will be closed tonight and will remain closed until Thursday evening.

The Corps Water Management System (CWMS) modeling suite is run when precipitation is anticipated to help plan reservoir operations. This CWMS forecast was created by USACE on June 4, 2019 using the best data available at the time. It may or may not accurately reflect existing or future conditions. Updated reservoir forecasts will be provided if NWS substantially changes its precipitation forecast.




Figure 1. WGRFC 24-hr QPF




Figure 2. NCEP 7-day QPF
