# BIOGRAPHY

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## **Shamekia M. Chapman**

District Chief of Contracting  
U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Galveston District

Shamekia M. Chapman serves as the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Galveston District's contracting chief, a position she assumed in July 2021.

A 15-year USACE veteran, Chapman currently oversees the acquisition planning, execution, and oversight of all contracts awarded in the Galveston District. Contracts range from horizontal construction of civil works projects such as maintenance dredging, channel deepening, levee repair/replacements, pump stations, and ecological restoration to hydro/topographic surveys, design support, grounds maintenance and janitorial services; at about \$400 million per year.

She also leads a team tasked with executing a \$7 billion horizontal construction multiple award task order contract (MATOC) and a \$775 million architect-engineer services MATOC; two of the largest acquisition tools in USACE.



Before assuming her current position, Chapman served as the Galveston District's Business Oversight Branch (BOB) chief since September of 2018. During her time in the BOB, she was responsible for policy development and implementation, compliance reviews, developing and managing the division's budget, training and career field certification, the General Purchase Condition program, and document reviews. In addition, Chapman was integral in the district gaining back its contracting authority separate from the Ft. Worth District and standing up the Galveston Contracting Division after an 8-year hiatus. With her assistance, the division grew from a branch of 5 to a division of 18.

She has been a USACE employee since 2006. Her background consists of extensive experience within the Corps of Engineers, ranging from deputy for the small business programs at Galveston; a procurement analyst; supplies and services section chief; medical command support team contracting officer; contract specialist at the Mobile District; cost/price analyst at the Ft. Hood Army Contracting Command; and contract specialist for the Unaccompanied Personnel Housing furniture program at the Huntsville Engineering and Support Center.

Chapman earned a Bachelor of Science in Finance from Alabama Agricultural and Mechanical University in 2007. She is Level 3 Certified in the Contracting Career Field.
