Ms. Ciarrocca began her career with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in 2018 when she moved to the Galveston District from Washington, DC. She joined the SWG Real Estate team as a Cartographer. Within a year, she completed the District's initiative for Civil Works Data Land Migration. In her current role, she provides mapping support for the acquisition of real property within the District, and management of the District's real estate GIS data.

From 2014 until the time she joined the Corps, she worked as a Cartographer at the U.S. Geological Survey in Reston, Virginia. There, she led in the development and maintenance of the USGS GIS project websites, MapView, and NGMDB Catalog. She worked closely with USGS scientists, and specialized in Lidar processing.

Prior to joining the Government, Ms. Ciarrocca graduated from George Mason University in 2016 with a degree in Geography and a double minor in GIS and Intelligence Analysis. During her four years at George Mason, she led several award-winning studies that evaluated network socio-geographic dynamics, firefighter safety, and site suitability.
