

Bob Stokes is President and General Counsel of the Galveston Bay Foundation in Kemah, Texas. He has served in that role since June, 2004. The Galveston Bay Foundation's mission is to preserve, protect, and enhance the natural resources of Galveston Bay and its tributaries.
