Basic Requirements for GS-12

A. A 4-year course of study leading to a bachelor's degree with a major in any field; Or

B. At least 24 semester hours in any combination of the following fields: accounting, business, finance, law, contracts, purchasing, economics, industrial management, marketing, quantitative methods, or organization and management.

Specialized Experience:

One year of specialized experience at the next lower grade (GS-11) which includes: 1) Performing pre-award functions such as: analyzing contractor proposals, supporting documentation, and developing special contracting language and developing solicitations AND 2) performing all post-award contracting work such as: the preparation of requests for price proposal letters, performance of all required audits, issuance of delivery orders, and preparation of modifications.

Conditions of Employment:

- Incumbent is required to submit a Financial Disclosure Statement, OGE-450.
- This is an Army Acquisition, Technology, and Logistics (AT and L) Workforce position.
- Must achieve DAWIA contracting Level 2 Certification with 24 months of employment
