Mr. Kenny Pablo is the Lead Realty Specialist for the Acquisition and Realty Services Branch of the Real Estate Division in the Galveston District. Mr. Pablo has been with the Corps since 2010 and has served in his current role for twelve years. At present, Mr. Pablo provides technical guidance to Real Estate Division's Acquisition Branch Realty Specialists. Mr. Pablo and his team support projects in the feasibility; pre-construction, engineering, and design; construction; and post-construction phases. Mr. Pablo has worked on a host of studies across the Civil Works spectrum including deep- and shallow-draft navigational studies and dredged material management plans (DMMPs), coastal storm risk management projects, and flood risk management projects, and ecosystem restoration projects. Mr.

Pablo has also performed acquisition work for projects such as the Customs and Border Patrol Freer Border Patrol Station, Falfurrias Checkpoint Station, and the Rio Grande City Border Patrol Station; as well as for U.S. Department of Transportation, Maritime Administration's Layberth Facility Project in Beaumont, Texas.

A sampling of Mr. Pablo's current Civil Works project portfolio includes the mega projects such as Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay Coastal Storm Risk Management Program, which includes three distinct reaches of Port Arthur, Freeport, and Orange County, Texas; the mega Coastal Texas Protection and Restoration project, spanning the length of the Texas Coast; the Houston Ship Channel 45-Foot Expansion Channel Improvement Project; the Greens Bayou Houston, Texas Flood Damage Reduction Project; the Cedar Bayou DMMP; the Chocolate Bayou DMMP; the Houston Ship Channel DMMP; the Corpus Christi Ship Channel Project; the Texas City Channel Improvement Project; and the Addicks and Barker Dam Safety Project. Additionally, Mr. Pablo has been instrumental to advancing the real estate profession within the Corps. Mr. Pablo and his Galveston Real Estate team modernized real estate processes including right of entry tracking and land acquisition and relocation tracking, enhancing collaboration amongst internal and external teams.
