Sabine to Galveston Port Arthur and Vicinity Finding of No Significant Impact

The public is hereby notified of the availability of the Draft Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay Port Arthur and Vicinity, Jefferson County, Texas. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Galveston District prepared the Draft FONSI to side with the Draft Supplemental Environmental Assessment that identified, evaluated, and disclosed all impacts from supplemental work associated with this project that were not previously disclosed in the 2017 *Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay, Texas Coastal Storm Risk Management and Ecosystem Restoration Final Integrated Feasibility Report and Environmental Impact Statement*.

A 30-day public comment period begins on Thursday, February 6, 2025, and ends Friday, February 21, 2025. The Draft FONSI will be available on the Galveston District website starting, February 6, 2025, at:
