2. The Galveston District, as the lead District for the State of Texas, prepared SDDs for the regional conditions (RCs) to the nationwide permits (NWP) in Texas. All of the districts with areas of responsibility within Texas have reviewed and commented on these RCs. Their comments and concerns have been addressed in the SDDs.

3. By the enclosed Memorandum for Record I have approved the applicable SDDs and RCs, including water quality certification, for the NWP published in the 6 January 2017 issue of the *Federal Register* (82 FR 1860) for use within SWD's area of responsibility in the State of Texas with the exception of water quality certification for NWP 16, which I have considered denied based on unenforceability. The RCs are now effective in SWD's portion of Texas (encl 2).

4. For your review and approval within your area of responsibility, we have provided your staff with electronic versions of the SDDs that include RCs for the State of Texas.
