the tides. There are no features that have lateral limits of jurisdiction (e.g., OHWM). Based on historical aerial imagery from Google Earth and topographic maps, the proposed site area lacks any hydrological connections to navigable waters. Work primarily involves the construction of a building and parking lot within undeveloped area without any apparent wetland signatures and lacking any wetland parameters (hydric soils, hydrophytic vegetation, and wetland hydrology).
