## Galveston District Regulatory Program Workshop

**PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE:** To inform you of that the U.S Army Corps of Engineers, Galveston District (Corps) is hosting a Workshop on the Regulatory program for all interested parties.

**DATE:** May 30, 2019 from 8:30-16:30. Doors will open at 8am.

**AGENDA:** Workshop topics will include: 1) Introduction from the COL. Lars Zetterstrom, Commander; 2) Introduction to the Regulatory Program including basic authorities, geographic jurisdiction, permit types, public interest review, 404(b)(1) Factual Determinations & Alternatives Analysis as well as coordination under Section 401, Coastal Zone Management, Endangered Species Act, Essential Fish Habitat, National Historic Preservation Act as well as a discussion on federally complete administrative records vs. administrative records complete for decision making; 3) The State of Galveston Regulatory, an overview of Regulatory staffing, budgets, current permit loads, Clean Water Rulemaking, Water Resource Development Act Section 214 funding agreements, and other challenges; 4) Roadblocks of the Permit Evaluation Process including discussion on incomplete permit applications and/or drawings, poor alternative analysis/siting criteria, lack of response to public comments; 5) Roadblocks of the JD & Delineation Verification Process including following the Manual/Supplements, filling out data sheets; 6) Integrating Regulatory and the 408/Real Estate Processes; and 7) a Listening Panel Session.
